ORDINANCE No. 185051

Extend term of a telecommunications franchise granted to MCI Communications Services, Inc. to build and operate telecommunication facilities within City streets (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 170954)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On February 26, 1997 the Council granted a franchise to Worldcom Network Services, Inc., to use the City streets to provide competitive telecommunications services. Ordinance No.170954.
- 2. In 2001, MCI Worldcom Network Services, Inc. notified the City that it was the successor to Worldcom Network Services, Inc. In December, 2005 the operating assets of MCl Network Services, Inc. and its predecessors including MCI Worldcom Network Services, Inc. and Worldcom Network Services, Inc. were assigned to MCI Communications Services, Inc. ("MCI").
- 3. The Council previously extended the term of MCI's telecommunications franchise until December 31, 2011. Ordinance No. 183365.
- 4. On October 26, 2011, the City Council adopted non-emergency Ordinance No. 184957, amending Title 17 of the Portland City Code. Among other matters, the ordinance updated, clarified and reorganized various code sections. The Bureau of Transportation will need to adopt administrative regulations implementing various aspects of the revised code provisions. This process will affect some of the standard franchise language. As the bureau works to complete this process, the Office for Community Technology is recommending that the Council extend existing franchises.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No.170954 is hereby amended to extend the term of the franchise, continuously and without interruption, through December 31, 2012.
- b. All other terms and conditions of the franchise shall remain the same and unchanged.
- c. On or before the thirtieth (30th) day after this ordinance becomes effective, MCI Communications Services, Inc. shall file in the Office of the Auditor of the City of Portland a written acceptance of this ordinance, executed by a duly authorized representative of MCI Communications Services, Inc., meeting the approval of the City Attorney. Any failure on the part of MCI Communications Services, Inc. to file such written acceptance within such time shall be deemed an abandonment and rejection of the rights and privileges conferred hereby and this ordinance shall thereupon be null and void. Such acceptance shall be unqualified and shall be construed to be an acceptance of all the terms contained in this ordinance.
