The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating two new represented classifications effective October 25, 2011.
- The business needs that these classifications are intended to meet cannot be fulfilled until the classifications and wage rates are established, however the wage rates for the classifications must be collectively bargained with District Council of Trade Unions (DCTU), Laborers' International Union, Local 483. Under Article 26.5.1 of the DCTU contract, the City may establish interim rates during bargaining.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
