

# ORDINANCE No. 185089

\*Authorize a contract for the construction of the Emergency SW Harrison Street Sewer Repair Project No. E10360 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Sanitary sewer rehabilitation is needed to prevent failure of sewer(s) and destabilization of roadway pavement and street car tracks.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
3. The established cost is \$598,417. The level of confidence in this estimate is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2011-2012 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services Cost Object, E10360.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with Insituform Technologies, Incorporated, for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$598,417.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delaying the rehabilitation of the SW Harrison Street sanitary sewer will cause sewer failure and destabilize roadway pavement and street car tracks. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


