TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has reviewed the request by CityFleet to purchase 64 Ford Crown Victoria police sedans and subsequently reviewed the procurement options available to the City. Council authorized the City to initiate the purchase for this equipment by Ordinance No. 183395 in December 9, 2009. It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City to utilize the State of Oregon price agreement for these vehicles.

On May 6, 2010, a cooperative procurement Notice of Intent was posted on the Procurement Services website to allow for public comment on the proposed vehicle purchase, no comments were received.

The estimated cost of this procurement will be approximately \$1,460,000.for the purchase and delivery of the vehicles. Funds are available in the CityFleet replacement fund in FY 2009-10. CityFleet has budgeted in the FY 2009-10 capital replacement budget for procurement of these 64 vehicles and there will be no increase in ongoing operations or maintenance for replacement vehicles for the Police Bureau.

It is recommended that a contract be issued to Landmark Ford using the State of Oregon price agreement for the purchase of 64 Ford Crown Victoria police sedans. Landmark Ford has a current City of Portland Business License, EEO certification is valid through March 31, 2011, and is in Full Compliance with the City's Equal Benefits Ordinance. The firm is located in Tigard, Oregon and is not an Oregon state certified M/W/ESB contractor.

Therefore it is recommended by the Chief Procurement Officer that a contract be executed with Landmark Ford for the purchase of 64 Ford Crown Victoria police sedans. The resulting procurement will not exceed \$1,460,000 and CityFleet rates the level of confidence as Optimal.
