ORDINANCE No. 185144

*Authorize \$50,000 for grant sponsorship agreements with Center for Intercultural Organizing, Immigrant Refugee Community Organization, Latino Network, Native American Youth and Family Center and Urban League of Portland for the Diversity and Civic Leadership Organizing Project to support culturally-appropriate public engagement in Portland Plan implementation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1: The Council Finds:

- 1. On August 11, 2008 the Portland City Council transmitted a periodic review work program to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development to update the City of Portland's Comprehensive Plan, which included a public engagement committee and work program.
- 2. Since that time, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) and partner agencies such as the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) have been promoting and conducting outreach and engagement activities to involve as many Portlanders as possible in the first part of the Comprehensive Plan Update the Portland Plan. The City's Community Involvement Committee has supported and monitored public engagement efforts.
- 3. On June 9, 2010, citing recent City efforts to increase community involvement, City Council approved Ordinance No. 183877 providing financial assistance to five Diversity and Civic Leadership (DCL) organizations to design culturally-appropriate public engagement activities that would build capacity in their organizations, and increase participation of their communities in Portland Plan events. The five DCL organizations are: Center for Intercultural Organizing (CIO), Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization (IRCO), Latino Network, Native American Youth and Family Center (NAYA), and Urban League of Portland.
- 4. BPS will continue work on implementation of the Portland Plan and update of the City's Comprehensive Plan through 2013. Continued involvement of the five DCL-partner organizations partnering with BPS staff in public involvement efforts advances City objectives to increase community involvement, engage underrepresented and ethnic communities and promote those communities' input in public decision-making.
- 5. The term of each sponsorship grant is 12 months (July 2011 to June 2012; July 2012 to June 2013). Each payment will be paid in full and cleared upon invoice each fiscal year. Funding for FY 2012-2013 will be by grant amendment.
- 6. This ordinance allows \$25,000 in funds appropriated in the Bureau of Planning and

Sustainability's Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12 budget and \$25,000 anticipated in the Bureau's FY 2012-13 budget, for distribution of grants amounting to \$5,000 each year to each of the five DCL-partner organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to enter into individual or cooperative sponsorship grant agreements pursuant to an agreement in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibit A with the Center for Intercultural Organizing, the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization, the Latino Network, the Native American Youth and Family Center, and the Urban League of Portland to conduct culturally-appropriate education, outreach and engagement of their communities in the implementation of the Portland Plan and the Comprehensive Plan update. The Director or the Director's designee is authorized to amend and renew the Grant Agreement in accordance with the Grant Agreement and provided that the funds have been allocated in the City budget for fiscal years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because work in the community to implement the Portland Plan and update the Comprehensive Plan is ongoing. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
