ORDINANCE No. 185191

*Amend agreement with Portland Streetcar, Inc. for vehicle engineering services related to streetcar vehicles being procured from Oregon Iron Works for the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001193)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 8, 2009, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 182999 authorizing a contract with Oregon Iron Works, Inc. (OIW) for the production and delivery of streetcar vehicles for the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Project).
- 2. On February 3, 2010, the Council passed Ordinance No. 183519, as amended, authorizing an agreement with Portland Streetcar, Inc. (PSI) for vehicle engineering services (Contract) related to the Project.
- 3. The Contract provides for PSI to retain LTK Engineering Services (LTK), as a subcontractor, to carry our vehicle engineering services related to the design and manufacture of streetcar vehicles by OIW.
- 4. Skoda in the Czech Republic, supplier of the electrical propulsion system for the Prototype Streetcar vehicle and named as the supplier of that system for the Loop Project vehicles, was unable or unwilling to deliver a satisfactory electrical propulsion system on the Prototype Streetcar vehicle. This lead to OIW requesting approval of other suppliers, which lead to the involvement of project participants in protracted analysis and negotiations and ended with approval of Change Order No. 1 to City/OIW Contract No. 30000696 by the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) on July 20, 2010. Changes Order No. 1, among other things, provided for the substitution of an alternative electrical propulsion system supplier and a delay in delivery from February to July 2012 for the first vehicle.
- 5. The Contract recognized that the propulsion system supplier substitution would likely require additional services and that modification to the Contract would be negotiated to include the additional costs of these services.
- 6. The City Project Manager and the Portland Bureau of Transportation have reviewed and approved the basis for and the cost of the additional services that will be performed by LTK as a subcontractor to PSI. The additional cost totals \$348,522, increasing the total maximum compensation to \$1,348,522.
- 7. There are adequate uncommitted Project contingency funds to cover the cost of the required additional vehicle engineering services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. 30001193, substantially in accordance with the Amendment attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Portland Streetcar, Inc., chargeable to the Transportation Operating Fund, Fund 200000, Business Area TR00.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because of the need not to interrupt the processes to complete and deliver the streetcar vehicles for the Portland Streetcar Loop Project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
