

ORDINANCE No. 185192

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2011 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program Grant funds to reimburse the County for a Deputy District Attorney (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will provide grant funding under the FY 2011 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program (IPCEP) Grant;
2. The Portland Police Bureau desires to use the services of the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office to perform services related to prosecuting intellectual property crimes;
3. Multnomah County will be a sub-recipient of funds to provide a 0.5 FTE Deputy District Attorney assigned to prosecute IPCEP cases for 12 months or until grant funds are expended;
4. The City will, with ODOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse Multnomah County, Oregon for the cost of all approved program expenses not to exceed \$89,913; and
5. This agreement shall begin October 1, 2011, and extend through September 30, 2012, or until grant funds are exhausted, whichever comes first, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this authorization will delay the City and County from receiving the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
