

## ORDINANCE No. 185240

\*Accept a grant from and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Health & Science University for the use of grant funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to support the Partnership to Improve Workplace Safety for In-Home Care Workers project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the Center for Disease Control and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health awarded grant funding to Johns Hopkins University who subsequently awarded Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) a subcontract for support of the project entitled "Partnership to Improve Workplace Safety for In-Home Care Workers;"
2. Oregon Health & Science University collaborated with the Police Bureau Women's Strength program (subawardee) because the subawardee had the skilled personnel and facilities available to undertake such a project;
3. The purpose of the agreement, OHSU subaward No. GRROE0147\_PPB, is for OHSU to provide funds to the City of Portland, Oregon, Police Bureau. The Women's Strength Program Coordinator will work with research associates from OHSU and Portland State University (PSU) to develop a computer-based training module related to the prevention and handling of violent situations for In-Home Care workers;
4. Oregon Health & Science University will reimburse the City \$10,809 for payroll expenses associated with the Women's Strength Program Coordinator's time spent on the research project;
5. There is no local grant match requirement; and
6. The terms of this agreement are retroactively effective September 1, 2010, through August 31, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland grant funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, administered by Oregon Health & Science University to support the research work performed by the Women's Strength Program Coordinator in the amount of \$10,809.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

- c. The FY 2011-12 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001

Business Area – PL00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$10,809

- d. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- e. The Police Chief of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Oregon Health & Science University grant #GCROE147C\_PPB provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to receive reimbursement for the work performed. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
