Accept donation of two ACU-1000 Communications Units from the State of Oregon (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Oregon Department of Transportation Statewide Interoperability Coordinator has offered to donate two ACU-1000 Communications Units to the City of Portland, Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM). These units are valued at \$7,150 each, for a total of \$14,300.
- 2. The primary use of the ACU-1000 is to simultaneously connect different radio networks and connect radio networks to telephone or satellite communication systems.
- 3. The primary location for the units will be in the PBEM communications trailer.
- 4. Per PCC 5.36.090 (A) the Mayor is authorized to accept any and all personal property or the use thereof.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept the donation of two ACU-1000 Communications Units from the State.
- b. PBEM is directed to add the two ACU-1000 Communications Units to the City's inventory.
