ORDINANCE No. 185266 As Amendeo

Authorize marketing agreements for the Portland Loo (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. For the past several years, the City of Portland, along with local businesses and downtown residents have advocated for more easily accessible public toilets. Pursuant to this effort, the City executed several contracts to fabricate a public restroom, now known as the Portland Loo.
 - 2. Curtis Banger, doing business as CB Design, was hired by the City pursuant to Contract No. 3776 5 on December 12, 2007 to provide design services for the Loo.
 - 3. Madden Industrial Craftsmen, Inc., dba Madden Fabrication was hired by the City pursuant to Contract No. 31000160 to fabricate the Loo.
 - 4. The City is now the holder of United States Design Patent No. US D622,408S for the Loo.
 - 5. Loos have now been fabricated and installed in five locations in downtown Portland and have provided a resource for basic human needs.
 - 6. CB Design and Madden Fabrication, Inc. who were involved, respectively, in the design and fabrication of the Loo, are uniquely qualified to market the Loo. In fact, some jurisdictions are interested in the Loo as a result of prior efforts.
 - 7. Another person uniquely situated to market the Loo is Carol McCreary. Ms. McCreary is a Principal Associate with Steel Bridge, a local consulting firm; on the Board of the Old Town Chinatown Neighborhood Association; and a founder of Public Hygiene Lets us Stay Human (PHLUSH), a grassroots all-volunteer toilet advocacy organization based in Portland's Old Town Chinatown. PHLUSH receives support from the Old Town Chinatown Neighborhood Association and Neighbors West-Northwest, is a member of the World Toilet Organization, a partner in the Sustainable Sanitation Alliance, and serves on the global public toilet design committee of the International Code Council. Organization. Ms. McCreary has made international presentations about the Portland Loo.
 - 8. The City now has the opportunity to market and sell the Loo to other entities, including public agencies.
 - 9. The best people to market the Loo are those who are most familiar with its operation and design, or who are recognized advocates for public restrooms.

- 10. It is desirable for the City to enter into contracts with CB Design, Madden Fabrication, Inc. and Carol McCreary to market the Loo and to be compensated if they are successful for their efforts, as outlined in the proposed contracts attached as Exhibits A, B and C to this ordinance.
- 11. These contracts might qualify as "sole source" contracts given the unique qualifications of the proposed contractors, but if the City Code, Chapter 5.68, requires competition, then that provision should be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of the Water Bureau is hereby authorized to execute contracts in substantially similar form to those attached as Exhibits A, B and C to this ordinance.
- b. If applicable, the provisions of City Code Chapter 5.68 in regard to competition are waived.
