## **ORDINANCE** No. 185276

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro and accept a grant in the amount of \$17,000 from Metro for five Portland Sunday Parkways in 2012. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to Metro for a grant in the amount of \$17,000 for five Portland Sunday Parkways in 2012.
- 2. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Portland Sunday Parkways to PBOT in the amount of \$17,000.
- 3. The PBOT Vision calls for a balanced, multi-modal transportation system where residents will have a broad range of safe and convenient transportation options and will frequently walk, bicycle, carpool, or ride public transit as their first choice of transportation.
- 4. Portland Sunday Parkways promotes healthy active living through a series of free events opening the city's largest public space -- its streets to walk, bike, roll, and discover active transportation. Portland Sunday Parkways fosters civic pride, stimulates economic development, and represents the community, business and government investments in Portland's vitality, livability, and diversity.
- 5. The attached Intergovernmental Agreement allows Metro to apportion \$17,000 of the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funds to the City to administer five Sunday Parkways in 2012.
- 6. The City Attorney has reviewed the attached Intergovernmental Agreement.
- 7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is optimal.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro for Portland Sunday Parkways 2012 in the amount of \$17,000 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A and by reference made a part of.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund 217001 Business Area – TR00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$17,000

c. The Director of PBOT of the City of Portland is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
