## ORDINANCE No. 185278

\*Pay claim of Daniel Halsted involving Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The claim of Daniel Halsted, through his attorney Joseph Grube, filed a lawsuit asserting damages from wrongful detention and excessive force on the part of members of the Portland Police Bureau in an incident that occurred on June 17, 2008.
- 2. The claim was investigated initially by Risk Management Services and after suit was filed discovery was conducted by the City Attorney's Office. A jury trial commenced in the United States District Court and the plaintiff Daniel Halsted was awarded a total of \$206,000.00. The plaintiff is entitled to attorney fees and costs. Plaintiff has submitted a cost bill of \$3,250.00 and prevailing party attorney fees of \$68,790.00. The aggregate claim of the plaintiff is \$278,040.00
- 3. Following the jury award, settlement negotiations were commenced and to resolve the matter without appeal or further litigation, plaintiff reduced his claim by \$20,000.00 to \$258,040.00.
- 4. The City Attorney's Office and the Portland Police Bureau recommend that the lawsuit be compromised for the sum of \$258,040.00 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$258,040.00 made payable to Daniel Halsted and his attorney Joseph Grube.
- b. The City Attorney's Office will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in resolving this pending litigation; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
