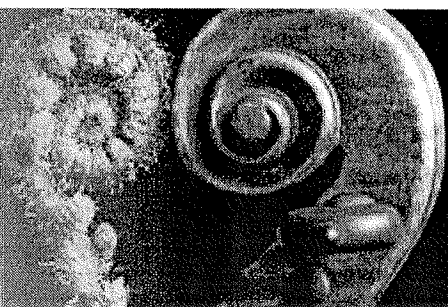
Other free activities coming soon:
