- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Changing the name of the Portland Office of Emergency Management to Portland Bureau of Emergency Management is consistent with the naming convention of City bureaus. Resolution 36881, passed by Council on September 211 2011, directed an ordinance to be drafted making that change. The ordinance will authorize changing the bureau's name as well as allowing for Portland Bureau of Emergency Management to be substituted for Portland Office of Emergency Management throughout City code or City Policy documents wherever necessary to provide consistency in official City references.
