## TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 111246 for the Outfall 27/Sellwood Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project No. E08467 for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of $\$ 16,600,000.00$.

Bids were opened on December 22, 2009, and five (5) bids were received. The low bid of Slayden Construction Group, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. It is recommended that the bid of Slayden Construction Group, Inc. be accepted at the total base bid quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of $\$ 7,317,491.50$. The Bureau of Environmental Services rates the level of confidence in the project cost as Optimal.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified twenty-five (25) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in $\$ 3,550,914.50$ awarded to subcontractors.
