ORDINANCE No. 6 6 185328

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the Portland Development Commission, Multhomah County and Portland State University to fund a development for co-location within the Education Urban Renewal Area (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Health is one of the top four overarching goals of the Portland Plan.

Olar - Sleep

- 2. Multnomah County leads public health efforts in the City of Portland and throughout the County.
- 3. The mission of Multnomah County's Department of Human Services ("DHS") is "to enhance the quality of life for individuals and families," and its vision is to foster "safe, healthy, caring and diverse communities where hope, independence, learning and opportunity prevail for all."
- 4. Portland State University has significant academic programs in human services and community health.
- 5. The motto of Portland State University ("PSU") is "let knowledge serve the city."
- 6. The City of Portland, Multnomah County and Portland State University seek to strengthen the positive connections that already exist between human health, higher education and supportive and affordable housing.
- 7. The Council is in the process of approving, by separate Ordinance, the Education Urban Renewal Plan, creating an urban renewal area and a strategy for accomplishing the urban renewal projects in the Education Urban Renewal Plan.
- 8. One of the projects identified in the Plan is to co-locate functions of DHS and compatible PSU academic and research programs in a development within the proposed Education Urban Renewal Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Portland Development Commission, Multnomah County and Portland State University, similar in form to Exhibit A, attached to this Ordinance, once such IGA has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
