ORDINANCE No.

Amend various sections of the Public Works Improvement Code for consistency of definitions and general language and organization cleanup. (Ordinance; replace code Chapter 17.04, amend code Chapters 3.13, 17.06, 17.24 – 17.26, 17.28, 17.32 - 17.39, 17.44, 17.76, and 17.80).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) is authorized to be the administrative lead on eight separate Chapters of the Portland City Code.
- 2. Many of the existing BES code provisions no longer reflect current program elements and commonly used definitions. Definitions need to be updated and made consistent across the eight chapters of Portland City Code(PCC) that BES administers. The language in many of these code chapters has remained unchanged for over twenty years.
- 3. Over the last year the City has received new National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant and City operated stormwater outfalls. In order to comply with some of the new permit requirements, minor code modifications are needed.
- 4. BES is proposing to centralize administrative rule making authorities to apply to all BES projects and authorities granted under the PCC.
- 5. BES is proposing changes to additional public works code sections in Title 17 to provide consistency and update language to support public works permit implementation.
- 6. BES has conducted a public review, included notice in the newspaper, of the proposed code changes and received limited public comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. That the proposed amendments be made to PCC Chapters 3.13, 17.06, 17.24 17.26, 17.28, 17.32 17.39, 17.44, 17.76, and 17.80, as outlined in Attachment A.
- b. That the Director of BES make corresponding changes to program administrative rules to reflect these changes. Administrative rule changes for Sanitary SDCs (ENB 4-05), Sewer Development Services Programs (ENB 4-07) and Clean River Rewards (ENB 4-14) programs shall be adopted on the same schedule as the proposed amendments to the PCC.


