

ORDINANCE No. 185405

*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to extend term date and add \$200,000. for purchase of digital imagery and data (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 53002)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In January 2008, City Council passed Ordinance No. 181489 which authorized the Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) Director, now known as the Chief Technology Officer, to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with Metro to obtain digital imagery and data purchased by Metro for the Aerial Photography Consortium (Consortium).
2. The Consortium enables the joint purchase of digital aerial photography, digital terrain models, vector contour data sets and other similar items required by Consortium members. The intent of the Consortium is to provide a cost-effective means to acquire these products. Metro purchases these products on behalf of the Consortium. The costs are then prorated among the participating Consortium members.
3. This IGA allows Metro to invoice the City for its prorated share of these products and allows the City to pay Metro when an invoice is received and properly authorized.
4. The current expiration date of this IGA is May 31, 2012.
5. BTS wishes to continue its acquisition of these products by renewing this IGA for ten-years, making the new expiration date May 31, 2022, and increasing the value of the IGA by \$200,000.00 for a new total value not-to-exceed \$365,000.00

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to execute an amendment to the IGA with Metro in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit-A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would disrupt the continuity of the IGA and availability of the digital imagery to the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


