## ORDINANCE No. 185430

Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services to execute revenue generating Intergovernmental Agreements for laboratory analytical services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
  - 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services' (BES's) Water Pollution Control Laboratory (WPCL) provides laboratory analysis of environmental samples collected from surface water, sanitary sewers and stormwater samples.
  - 2. Other government agencies have a need for this type of water quality analysis and have requested the WPCL to provide water quality analysis services.
  - 3. ORS 190.010 authorizes local governments to enter into intergovernmental agreements for the performance of a function or activity.
  - 4. The WPCL will bill agencies on a project by project basis as services are provided. Payments will be deposited into the Sewer System Operating Fund and credited to the appropriate BES Cost Object.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute Intergovernmental Agreements in a form similar to the agreement template attached as Exhibit A and for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute amendments to these agreements provided that such amendment does not obligate BES to make payments to the other agency.


