ORDINANCE No. 185450

Adopt process for limited, short term exemptions from storing containers in the right-of-way for extreme economic hardships (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. PCC 17.102.290 prohibits storing solid waste, recycling or compostable containers in the public right-of-way, except under permits issued by the City.
- 2. PCC 17.102.290 allows for limited term exemptions to the prohibition for property or business owners for whom immediate compliance constitutes an extreme economic hardship.
- 3. As provided under PCC 17.102.290, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has developed administrative rules and procedures for determining extreme economic hardship. Staff recommends that the City Council approve the proposed administrative rules, as set forth in Exhibit A to this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The administrative rule developed by the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability addressing the process by which limited, short term exemptions from the restrictions upon containers in the right-of-way will be allowed for extreme economic hardships is adopted.
- b. Exhibit A to this ordinance is adopted as a binding city administrative rule.
