

## ORDINANCE No. 185492

\*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Peninsula Drainage District 2 for work at Columbia Slough Trail Denver Ave to Vancouver Ave (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City is the holder of trail easements over certain real properties that make up portions of the Columbia Slough Trail from "Denver to Vancouver Ave", within Peninsula Drainage District 2 (PDD2), a special District of the State of Oregon.

2. The PDD2 requires reinforcement of existing levees prior to completion of trail construction which will fill critical missing links in the overall 40 mile loop trail network as well as provide for increased flood protection for adjacent properties.

3. Pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, PDD2 will be granted entry for construction access. The PDD2 will be responsible for levee reinforcement per the attached agreement. Portland Park and Recreation (PP&R) will partner with PDD2 by providing funding for construction costs associated with this project.


NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Director of Portland Parks and Recreation is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with Peninsula Drainage District 2 for work at Columbia Slough Trail "Denver to Vancouver Ave".

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the execution of this agreement as it will adversely effect the City's ability to move forward with trail construction and Peninsula Drainage District 2 ability to mitigate flooding on this site; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
