ORDINANCE No. 185509

* Authorize a Grant Agreement with Mt. Hood Community College providing \$38,000 to implement the Future Connect Scholarship program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland's future economic and social well-being are dependent upon more students graduating from high school and pursuing further education; and
- 2. Only 56.4% of local students currently graduate high school on time and less than half of graduates go on to college; and
- 3. Only 56.6% of students who enroll in a four-year university and 25.1% of students who enroll in a two-year university earn a degree; and
- 4. City Council supported allocation of \$500,000 in Non-Property Tax General Funds in the 2011-12 Adopted Budget to institute a scholarship program for academically at-risk students; and
- 5. A key component of the Future Connect Scholarship Program is a system of supports. This important component of the Program needs to be set up prior to students beginning at Mt. Hood Community College in order for those students to be well served, which this funding would allow for.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with Mt. Hood Community College in a form substantially in accordance with the grant agreement attached as Exhibit A at a cost not to exceed \$38,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2012-13 Adopted Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program must be set up before the beginning of the school year; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
