ORDINANCE No. 185539

* Accept and appropriate additional grant funding in the amount of \$5,000 from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement grant program for personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (OACP) notified the City on July 12, 2012, that it has awarded the Police Bureau Traffic Division additional grant funding for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) grant program in the amount of \$5,000. The original award was \$65,000;
- 2. The OACP will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division personnel overtime hours worked on the DUII Traffic Safety and HVE grant program. The reimbursement rate is \$40.00 per hour;
- 3. The grant match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided by funds from City of Portland in the form of straight time personnel expenses and overtime expenses above the grant's \$40.00 per hour limit and all benefit expenses related to grant overtime (average is \$7,500 per month) in the FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 Police Bureau budget; and
- 4. The grant period remains October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland additional grant funding from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police in the amount of \$5,000 for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and HVE grant program.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – PL00

Bureau Program Expenses - \$5,000

c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OACP for the DUII Traffic Safety and HVE grant, award number #K2-12-12-38, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funding and completion of the grant's projects. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
