ORDINANCE No. 18555^2

Repeal Portland City Code Chapter 2.10 pertaining to the Campaign Finance Fund (Ordinance; repeal Code Chapter 2.10)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Chapter 1.01 of the City Charter requires the Auditor to maintain the City Code.
- 2. It is in the interest of all who rely upon the City Code to keep it as accurate and up-todate as possible.
- 3. According to City Code Section 2.10.240, Code Chapter 2.10 applies only to elections taking place on or before November 2, 2010.
- 4. City Council referred measure 26-108 to the voters at the November 2, 2010 General Election as measure 26-108. The measure would have allowed the Campaign Finance Fund code to remain effective after the November 2010 election.
- 5. The electorate of Portland did not approve measure 26-108 and therefore, Code Chapter 2.10 does not apply to any future elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. City Code Chapter 2.10 is hereby repealed.
- b. The repeal of Code Chapter 2.10 shall not affect any claims of the City that have been reduced to a judgment.
