ORDINANCE No. 185556

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the Oregon Department of Justice Criminal Justice Division for domestic marijuana eradication and suppression efforts (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ) Criminal Justice Division for grant funding to support marijuana eradication and suppression efforts in the Portland-Metropolitan area;
- 2. The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) provides annual funding to ODOJ in support of state and local law enforcement in the investigation and eradication of Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTO's) that manufacture marijuana. The ODOJ administers funds for approximately 30 law enforcement agencies through Letters of Understanding;
- 3. The Portland City Council requires that all agreements with the federal government contain the language, restrictions and terms set out in Exhibit A;
- 4. The ODOJ Criminal Justice Division has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for marijuana eradication and suppression to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$25,000. The grant period is January 1 December 31, 2012;
- 5. The ODOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$25,000 for investigative overtime associated with eradication and suppression missions; and
- 6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Justice in the amount of \$25,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Understanding & Amendment No. 1 with the ODOJ acting by and through its Criminal Justice Division substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- c. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows: <u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217

Business Area – PL00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$25,000

- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- e. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by ODOJ Criminal Justice Division for the 2012 Marijuana Eradication grant, award number LOA #2012-104, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
