ORDINANCE No. 185591

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Division St Reconstruction Project: SE 6th – Cesar Chavez Blvd. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) received a grant from Metro in the amount of \$2,500,000 for the Division Street Reconstruction Project in 2005.
- 2. On May 30, 2012, City Council passed Ordinance No. 185354 authorizing PBOT to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to receive the \$2,500,000 MTIP grant.
- 3. The Division Street Reconstruction Project implements the recommendations of the Division Street Reconstruction Project Streetscape Plan adopted by City Council in June 2010 (Resolution No. 36797).
- 4. This project is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2011-12 and proposed FY 2012-13 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is high as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00006 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is important to advertise this project as soon as possible to begin construction of pipe work before winter season and periods of high water; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
