ORDINANCE No. 185636

* Authorize a three-year contract with CASE Associates Inc. for Public Safety Systems Revitalization Program Quality Assurance Services for a total not-to-exceed \$388,080 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland's (City) Public Safety Systems Revitalization Program (PSSRP) was established to manage and coordinate the replacement and upgrade of the City's aging Public Safety Technology Systems.
- 2. The City requires quality assurance services to provide an independent evaluation of each of the large, critical public safety communication and application projects under the PSSRP umbrella.
- 3. Presently, the following projects under review include the law enforcement records management system, public safety radio system and fire information system.
- 4. On May 1, 2012, Procurement Services issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 114364 in accordance with Section 5.68 of the City Code, to solicit for quality assurance services for the PSSRP. Proposals were opened on May 21, 2012 and five responsive proposals were received. The evaluation committee determined CASE Associates Inc. to be the most qualified proposer.
- 5. The City desires to enter into a Professional, Technical & Expert (PTE) contract with CASE Associates Inc., with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$388,080.00.
- 6. The PSSRP will make contractual payments utilizing existing program resources within the General Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a contract with CASE Associates Inc. on behalf of the City in a form substantially in conformance with the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute amendments to this agreement, provided the contract amendment has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in executing the contract would affect PSSRP's ability to receive continuous quality assurance services to critical City and public safety related technology capital projects; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
