7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On May 24, 1989, Council approved Ordinance No. 161964 which established City Code Chapter 5.10 governing Payroll Deductions for Charitable Purposes.

City Code Chapter 5.10 was subsequently amended on June 27, 1991 by Ordinance No. 164381, on August 26, 1992 by Ordinance No. 165770, on April 5, 1995 by Ordinance No. 168638, on August 27, 2003 by Ordinance No. 177883, and on December 19, 2007 by Ordinance No. 181483.

These amendments meant that requirements for the charitable organizations were described in several separate sections of Code.

The substitute chapter changes the title from "Payroll Deductions for Charitable Purposes" to "City Charitable Campaign" and is intended to streamline and update the overall Code, clarify requirements by grouping them together, eliminate duplication, remove specific campaign dates from Code, and update payroll deduction language.

Key requirements within the Code would remain in effect, including the requirement for Council authorization of participating umbrella organizations, the requirement for participating umbrella and charitable organizations to have a non-discrimination policy, the requirement for the fundraising and administrative expenses of the umbrella organization to not exceed 25 percent of unrestricted income, and the requirement for the administrative costs of the annual campaign to be paid by the participating umbrella organizations.
