

**ORDINANCE NO. 185757**

\*Authorize multiple applications to the Oregon Department of Transportation for grants in the amount of up to \$39.125 million for transportation enhancement projects. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Through the State Transportation Improvement Program's Enhance Fund, the Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting projects that enhance or improve the existing transportation network.
2. Working with stakeholders, the Bureaus of Transportation, Planning and Sustainability, and Parks and Recreation identified 14 priority projects for submittal to the Enhance grant fund.
3. The projects identified improve safety and multi-modal access across Portland.
4. The attached list of projects (Attachment A) was developed with the City's Bicycle, Pedestrian and Freight Advisory Committees.
5. Local match in the amount of 10.27% of total project cost will be provided by funds from various sources including the Bureau of Transportation, TriMet, Portland Development Commission and System Development Charges.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for the grants listed on Attachment A in the amount of up to \$39.125 million.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grants are due immediately; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
