ORDINANCE No. 185777

*Authorize an emergency contract and provide payment for the construction of the Fanno Force Main Hydraulic Surge Tank Project No. E10477 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has determined that a threat to health and property exists due to the failure of the Fanno Force Main owned by BES resulting in sewage being released to the ground in public areas. The Bureau has conducted engineering studies of the force main and the operation of the Fanno Pump Station and found the need for immediate expansion of the pump station and modifications to the force main in order to meet capacity needs of the basin and to remedy the persistent failures.
- 2. BES has had to enter into a wholesale sewer services agreement with Clean Water Services for conveyance and treatment of City sewage flows discharged from the Fanno Creek Basin service area to mitigate the risk exposure. Until this system is put into place, areas of Washington County will be at risk to health and property damage. Each day the system is inoperable the City will incur additional mitigation costs.
- 3. This project will require specialty expertise to excavate, modify the steel force main, add a surge tank, and controls with minimum delay. Given the urgency needed to complete this work, the Commissioner-in-Charge of BES has signed a letter to the Chief Procurement Officer declaring an emergency and recommending the work be competitively bid to the following contractors who have been determined to have the expertise required: Moore Excavation, Inc., Emery & Sons Construction, and James W. Fowler Co. Accordingly, BES has prepared construction documents for this project.
- 4. The Estimated cost is \$1,000,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is low. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013 Budget, and BES Project No. E10477.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. Approval of an emergency contract for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.

- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the imminent threat to health and property due to continued failure of the Fanno Force Main owned by BES. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
