WHEREAS the Council of the City of Portland referred to the voters of the City at the Municipal non-partisan General Election held on November 6, 2012, a measure with the ballot title caption "Restore School Arts, Music Education; Fund Arts through Limited Tax," and such measure was designated on the ballot as Measure 26-146, and according to the official canvas 178,725 votes were cast in favor of said measure, and 107,953 were cast against said measure, now, therefore, it is hereby


