

ORDINANCE No. 185841

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$4,013,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the East Portland Access to Transit Project and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for a grant in the amount of \$4,013,000 for the East Portland Access to Transit project in March of 2012.
2. ODOT has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the East Portland Access to Transit in the amount of \$4,013,000, where City of Portland will receive amount of \$4,005,500 and ODOT will perform work estimated at \$7,500.
3. PBOT's application was developed utilizing the East Portland Action Plan and the East Portland in Motion plans to provide connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists in East Portland where they are lacking.
4. The East Portland Access to Transit project will provide crossing improvements for pedestrians on busier streets like SE Division and SE 122nd, sidewalk infill for missing segments on SE Division, and bikeway improvements on the "130's" bikeway and SE Division.
5. The East Portland Access to Transit project will provide these improvements to focus on better accessing transit by constructing crossings at bus stops with high volumes of boarding and de-boarding and to provide the connections to the neighborhoods where residents are coming from to access transit lines.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the East Portland Access to Transit project in the amount of \$4,013,000 and authorize the Mayor to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.

- b. The FY 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – TR

Bureau Program Expenses - \$50,000

- c. The Mayor is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


