

ORDINANCE No. 185855

*Accept an FY 2012 Emergency Management Performance Grant in the amount of \$227,548 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) provides financial and technical assistance through their Fiscal Year 2012 grant. These funds are provided for the development of an all hazard emergency management capability to promote planning, response, exercise, training and community outreach.
2. Council authorized application to FEMA for an Emergency Management Performance Grant under ordinance 185379 on June 6, 2012.
3. Minimal basic requirements for participation in the EMPG program are
 - a. Develop, revise and enhance emergency management plans.
 - b. Provide a comprehensive, all hazards training program to address the needs of local, state, federal, private sector, non-profit, and tribal entities.
 - c. Implement a comprehensive exercise program to assess and evaluate emergency plans and capabilities.
 - d. Attend a minimum of twenty hours of training, participate in quarterly exercises and submit appropriate reports to document actions taken.
4. Grant funds are budgeted for one half of the cost of three Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) positions, one half of the annual rent for PBEM office space, one half of plan development software and one half of the total cost of Emergency Coordination Center information technology operational support. All funds received through the EMPG program will be provided on a reimbursable basis and will be matched 50% in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2012-13 budget of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management.
5. All funds received through the EMPG program will be provided on a reimbursable basis and will be matched 100% by City of Portland general funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City in the amount of \$227,548.

- b. The FY 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – EM

Bureau Program Expenses – \$0

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Emergency Management of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by FEMA for Emergency Management Program Grant CFDA # 97.042, # 12-529, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


