## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to construct the SW 86<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances project to provide the required firm pumping capacity for the Fanno Creek Basin sewer collection and conveyance system.
- 2. The level of confidence in the estimated cost for a construction contract for the SW 86<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances project is optimal.
- 3. The estimated construction cost is \$14,526,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E09051.
