

ORDINANCE No. 185908

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the SW 86th Ave Pump Station and Appurtenances Project No. E09051 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to construct the SW 86th Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances project to provide the required firm pumping capacity for the Fanno Creek Basin sewer collection and conveyance system.
2. The level of confidence in the estimated cost for a construction contract for the SW 86th Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances project is optimal.
3. The estimated construction cost is \$14,526,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E09051.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

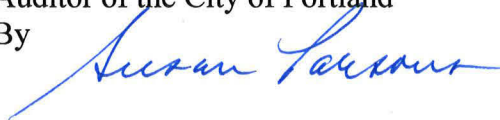
