## ORDINANCE No.

\*Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Portland Police Bureau and Multnomah County for the Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002122)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland (City) and Multnomah County (County) are committed to addressing the problem of prostitution in the city.
- 2. A program is currently in place to assist individuals in finding alternatives to prostitution.
- 3. The Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (SBAD) offers education for persons arrested for solicitation of prostitution about the legal, social, and health ramifications of the commercial sex trade.
- 4. The County contracts with Lifeworks Northwest to provide assistance in the design, development and implementation of the SBAD program.
- 5. The SBAD program charges \$1,000 per participant.
- 6. Lifeworks administers the SBAD program and retains 10% or \$1,400 for each session, whichever is greater, as reimbursement for administration and direct costs.
- 7. The remainder of the money collected is distributed to the Multnomah County District Attorney at 33%, the Portland Police Bureau at 34% and Lifeworks at 33%.
- 8. The current term of this agreement is from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012.
- 9. This amendment will extend the term of the intergovernmental agreement through December 31, 2014.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend the intergovernmental agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in executing the agreement may adversely impact the program and deny the parties of its benefits; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and affect from and after its passage by the Council.
