ORDINANCE No. 185930

Authorize contract and provide for payment for construction of SW Curry Closure Project
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Transportation and Oregon Department of Transportation identified vehicular access changes needed to facilitate development of the South Waterfront District.
2. The prohibition of vehicular right turns from the I-5 to SW Curry at Highway 43 and the addition of a right turn lanes at SW Harbor Drive were identified as the first tier of improvements.
3. Portland Bureau of Transportation staff coordinated with Oregon Department of Transportation in the development and design of modifications to SW Curry Street and signage on I-5 northbound.
4. The Bureau of Transportation hired HHPR to prepare plans, specifications and an estimate for the project construction.
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 12/13 to construct, inspect and manage the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. The project is defined and plans and specifications are 90% complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor is authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00370.C42 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.





