

ORDINANCE No.

*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with TriMet for support services related to the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001134)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Effective January 27, 2010, TriMet and the City entered into City IGA No. 30001134 (TriMet IGA No. GH100484TL) for the purpose of memorializing the parties' agreements relating to the City desire for TriMet's support and expertise on various matters for the construction of the Portland Streetcar Loop Project, which extends Streetcar service across the Broadway Bridge and south to the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry (Project).
2. The parties recognize added needs for TriMet's support and expertise because of expanded startup activities such as hiring and training personnel, scheduling, testing and other activities required for commencement of revenue services that are eligible for funding under the grant from the Federal Transit Administration.
3. The City and TriMet desire for all costs relating to TriMet's provision of support services for the Project to be reimbursed by the City and have agreed to a scope and budget for the added services, with needed resources available from Project contingency. The not-to-exceed compensation is increased from \$1,244,950 to \$2,089,816.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

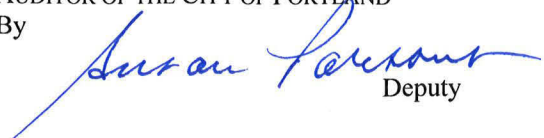
- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to amend the Intergovernmental Agreement No. 3000134 with TriMet, substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to TriMet, chargeable to the Transportation Operating Fund, Fund 200000, Business Area TR00.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists in that the civil, rail and electrical construction of the Portland Streetcar Loop is complete, revenue service has started and the City wishes to reimburse TriMet in a timely manner for their support services; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
