TO THE COUNCIL:

The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) has an on-going need for asphaltic concrete mixtures on an annual basis in order to perform routine road maintenance and paving work. Street maintenance can be located in various locations throughout the City, therefore the City has determined that more than one price agreement is necessary to ensure adequate and efficient availability and delivery of asphalt materials in cost effective manner. The use of any of the contractors will be based on availability, delivery, location of the workand inspection and testing to assure the best value to the bureau. On February 13, 2013, City Council passed Ordinance 185882 authorizing the use of a competitive invitation to bid (ITB) for asphalt supply contracts to be used by the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the performance of annual routine road maintenance and paving work.

On February 8, 2013, the Chief Procurement Officer advertised ITB #115045 for Asphalt Supply and received six (6) bids. The bids were reviewed and evaluated in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33. Bids from five (5) of the bidders were deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation and contract awards will be made to all responsive bidders. The contractual not-to-exceed amounts have been determined based on historical usage and two (2) of the contracts will require Council approval. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Award price agreements to all responsive bidderson March 1, 2013 and no protests are pending.

Porter W. Yett Company and K.F. Jacobsen & Company, Inc., have current City of Portland business licenses, are in full compliance with the Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certifications are current. These firms are located in the Portland metro area and are not State Certified MWESB contractors. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is High as there is very good historical information showing purchases made for this commodity.

The Chief Procurement Officer recommends that City Council authorize five year price agreements with Porter W. Yett Company for \$10,000,000.00 and K.F. Jacobsen & Company, Inc. for \$5,000,000.00 to provide asphaltic concrete mixtures
