ORDINANCE No. 185964

* Authorize application to Metro Regional Government for a package of four grants totaling \$1,235,500 as part of the Community Planning and Development Grant program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland City Council shares the Metro Council's goals for smart planning that readies land for development, removes barriers to private investment in development, and improves the livability of the region.
- 2. The Portland City Council is supportive of the extension of Community Planning and Development Grant program, and the potential allocation of funds to planning activities for areas inside the Urban Growth Boundary.
- 3. Staff in the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has reviewed the grant program, coordinated with several other City bureaus and agencies, submitted initial letters of intent to Metro in February 2013, and received feedback on seven potential proposals in March 2013.
- 4. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) seeks a grant of \$425,500 for the 'Mixed-Use Zoning Project'. City of Portland matching funds in the amount of \$207,917 will be provided by BPS in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 and FY 2014-15 budgets of BPS.
- 5. The Bureaus of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) and Transportation (PBOT) seek a grant of \$250,000 for the 'Central City Parking Policy Project'. City of Portland matching funds in the amount of \$125,000 will be provided by BPS and PBOT in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 budget of BPS and PBOT.
- 6. The Bureaus of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) and Transportation (PBOT) seek a grant of \$450,000 for the 'Powell-Division Transit and Development Project'. City of Portland matching funds in the amount of \$105,144 will be provided by BPS and PBOT in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 and FY 2014-15 budgets of BPS and PBOT.
- 7. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) seeks a grant of \$110,000 for the 'Campus Institution Zoning Update'. City of Portland matching funds in the amount of \$105,000 will be provided by BPS in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 budget of BPS.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Metro Regional Government for a package of four grants in the amount of \$1,235,500.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because grant applications are due no later than April 18, 2013. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
