

ORDINANCE No. 185966

* Authorize contract and provide for payment for installation of The Portland Building Emergency Generator at an estimated cost of \$570,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The design for The Portland Building Emergency Generator Replacement project is complete and construction documents have been prepared and is ready to out to public bid.
2. The replacement of The Portland Building Emergency Generator is estimated to be \$570,000. The construction estimate is within budget.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for The Portland Building Emergency Generator Installation project.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the year 2012-2013 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid additional expenses and a delay in the completion of this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
