ORDINANCE No.

Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to acquire certain easements and other real property interests necessary for construction of the Skidmore Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E10291 through the exercise of the City's Eminent Domain Authority (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services is proceeding with the Skidmore Pump Station Remodel Project to meet current design and safety standards, reduce ongoing maintenance expenses and improve the pump station's reliability.
- 2. The Skidmore Pump Station Remodel Project requires acquisition of a certain permanent and temporary easements to construct the project.
- 3. Acquisition efforts will be completed in accordance with Eminent Domain procedures provided for in ORS Chapter 35 (Eminent Domain; Public Acquisition of Property), including those procedures that apply to notification, valuation, negotiation, relocation and early possession if necessary.
- 4. It is necessary to acquire possession of the easement by October 1, 2013 so that construction can begin on schedule.
- 5. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013-2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project No. E10291, Account No. 563300 (permanent asset) and Account No. 549000 (temporary asset).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or his designee and/or City Attorney are authorized to acquire certain easements and other real property interests for the Skidmore Pump Station Remodel Project under the Eminent Domain Authority of the City, including filing an action to acquire the property interests described herein or negotiating just compensation with property owners within available project budget funds.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and/or City Attorney are further authorized to enter into obligations agreements with the property owner to address construction management or maintenance concerns within available project budget funds.
- c. There is hereby authorized the creation of a fund in the amount estimated to be the just compensation for the interest in the property which, if necessary, shall be deposited with the clerk of the court where an action is commenced.
- d. The costs incurred in connection with the acquisition authorized herein shall be charged to the Skidmore Pump Station Remodel Project No. E10291.

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e. The property affected by this ordinance is described as follows:

As described on Exhibit A and Exhibit C and depicted on Exhibit B and Exhibit D attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

f. The Commissioner in Charge and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
