ORDINANCE No. 186074

* Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County, acting by and through its District Attorney's Office to decrease funding in the amount of \$30,136 for child abuse investigations (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001158)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CAMI Grant provides funding from the Child Abuse Multi-disciplinary Intervention Account to Multnomah County District Attorney's Office in accordance with the grant application and awards.
- 2. The Police Bureau provides Detectives specially trained in conducting child abuse investigations including evening hours and on weekends to respond to child abuse referrals.
- 3. Intergovernmental Agreement No. 30001158 provided that Multnomah County District Attorney's Office would reimburse the Police Bureau for overtime hours worked by the Detectives investigating child abuse cases during evenings and weekends in an amount not to exceed \$64,000 from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
- 4. The agreement was amended on January 26, 2011 to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2011 and increase the compensation in an amount not to exceed \$64,000.
- 5. The agreement was amended on June 10, 2011 to decrease the dollar amount by \$3,500 for the agreement period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
- 6. The agreement was amended on December 16, 2011 to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2012 and increase the compensation in an amount not to exceed \$60,500.
- 7. The agreement was amended on April 20, 2012 to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2013 and increase the dollar amount by \$60,500 for the agreement period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.
- 8. Multnomah County and the City wish to further amend the agreement to decrease the dollar amount by \$30,135.87 for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.
- 9. All other terms and conditions shall remain the same and in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No.30001158 in a form substantially in accordance with the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this amendment will unnecessarily deprive the City and Multnomah County of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
