

ORDINANCE No. 186088

* Authorize a contract with Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. to provide mental health services through Project Respond (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. currently provides three Qualified Mental Health Professionals to ride along with uniformed police officers in patrol cars to provide on-scene mental health assessment and evaluation as part of the Behavioral Health Unit.
2. This partnership provides linkage to social service resources and uses the Raintree database to identify and follow up with individuals who are generating frequent police contact due to a mental health or emotional crisis.
3. A similar contract has existed between the City and Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare since 2011 and has been amended twice. In the past, the contract has been funded by one-time funding decided on a fiscal year to fiscal year basis.
4. The City and Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare wish to enter into a new one-year contract that reflects the current program for these services beginning July 1, 2013.
5. The value of the contract would be not to exceed amount of \$263,526.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City and Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. of the mutual benefits of this agreement. This amendment is time-sensitive to the fiscal year and as such cannot afford the longer processing time of a non-emergency ordinance. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
