ORDINANCE No. 186092

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon to receive Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages data from the State Employment Department (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Oregon State Employment Department makes available Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) data to public agencies for general research, mapping and statistical analysis of employment geography, types of employment and employment trends.
- 2. Metro, Portland Development Commission (PDC), the City of Portland and other public offices incorporate the data into geographic information system (GIS) data.
- 3. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has need of QCEW data to support planning projects, evaluate sustainability programs, provide guidance to businesses and develop performance measurements for projects.
- 4. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability will administer a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement with the State to request GIS data from Metro or PDC to incorporate into planning effots and to improve the City's commercial recycling and waste prevention programs.
- 5. Under the proposed intergovernmental agreement, the State will provide the confidential business data at no cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is authorized to enter an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Oregon Employment Department for receipt of data and to execute an agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is authorized to enter into one-year extensions or renewals of the intergovernmental agreement, or amendments that do no increase the City's financial risks, until the agreement is discontinued by written notice.

c. The Director of Bureau Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to Employment Department Agreement 13-243, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists for continuity of services. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
