## **ORDINANCE No.** 186097

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for participation in the fellowship program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Center for Public Service ("CPS") and Mark O. Hatfield School of Government at Portland State University (PSU) hosts several highly competitive fellowships that are designed to bring national class talent to Oregon public enterprises.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is beginning a process of centralizing its maintenance agreements to better identify and track maintenance expenditures to make sure that they are accounted for correctly.
- 3. PBOT has a long history of partnering with PSU on varied research and educational programs.
- 4. PBOT's participation in the fellowship program would provide additional real world experience to a PSU fellow while at the same time providing PBOT with additional planning, logistical, and administrative services.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is optimal. The cost for participation in PSU's fellowship program is a flat sponsorship fee of \$35,000.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for participation in PSU's fellowship program, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because PBOT seeks to initiate the work of the PSU fellow as soon as practicable; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
