ORDINANCE NO.

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with The Regents of the University of California for laboratory services for Cryptosporidium and Giardia scat analysis (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City recognizes that on March 14, 2012, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued its Final Order granting the City of Portland's request for a variance to the treatment requirements of the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule under 42 USC § 300g-4(a)(1)(B). The Bull Run Treatment Variance is subject to the conditions specified by OHA in the Final Order.
- 2. In order to comply with the scat monitoring condition of the Final Order and maintain the Bull Run Treatment Variance, the City must retain the services of a laboratory to test scat samples for the presence of Cryptosporidium oocysts.
- 3. The Western Institute for Food Safety and Security Laboratory, acting through The Regents of the University of California, was selected to complete this work.
- 4. The not-to-exceed value of this agreement is \$200,000. Funding for the project has been requested in the FY 2013-14 Budget and will be requested in FY 2014-15 through FY 2016-17 Budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Water Bureau Administrator is authorized to execute on behalf of the City an Intergovernmental Agreement with The Regents of the University of California to provide laboratory services in accordance with the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
- c. Amendments increasing the total compensation of the Intergovernmental Agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Water Bureau Administrator up to twenty-five percent of the total agreement amount. Any increase exceeding twenty-five percent of the total compensation would need City Council approval.
