*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the SW Oak St – Naito Pkwy to SW 10th Ave Road Rehabilitation project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pavement conditions on SW Oak St. between Naito Parkway and SW 10th Avenue have deteriorated to a point where they have been prioritized for significant preventative maintenance and rehabilitation.
- 2. SW Oak St is a city roadway that is essential to support vehicle movement, transit, and commerce in the downtown core.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation has prepared plans, specifications and an estimate for the preventative maintenance and rehabilitation of this roadway.
- 4. Funds to construct, inspect, and manage this project are available in the FY 2013-2014 budget.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. The Project is defined and plans and specifications are complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00318 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing this Ordinance will delay award of the project affecting the project completion; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
