ORDINANCE No. 186129

*Accept a grant from the Federal Highway Bridge Program for \$3.392 million and to authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to rehabilitate the historic NW Thurman Street Bridge 25B15 over Macleay Park. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The historic NW Thurman Street Bridge (25B15) was constructed in 1905 and is the oldest bridge in the City of Portland. Due to its age and deteriorating state, the bridge is currently in poor condition and is weight restricted.
- 2. The Bureau of Transportation applied to the Federal Highway Bridge Program for a grant in the amount of \$3.392 Million for the rehabilitation of the historic NW Thurman Street Bridge (25B15).
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation was notified on March 19, 2013, that it has been awarded the above grant, with the opportunity to begin design work immediately, and to bid the project for construction in August 2013.
- 4. The total project cost is estimated to be \$3.781 Million, of which \$3.392 million will be Federal Highway Bridge Program funding and \$388,309 will be local City match.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate as PBOT has carried out an engineering study of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Federal Highway Bridge Program for the rehabilitation of the historic NW Thurman St Bridge (25B15) in the amount of \$3.392 Million, and the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to secure the funding in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2012/13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANT FUND</u> Fund – 217 Business Area – TR00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$150,000

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Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Agreement requires the project plans to be completed July 17, 2013, in order to bid August 2013; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
