

# ORDINANCE No. 186211

\*Authorize contracts for towing and storage of vehicles (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Towing Board of Review, pursuant to Chapter 3.98 of the Code, has recommended approval by Council of the contract for vehicle towing and storage services in a form substantially similar to that attached as Exhibit "1."
2. The Towing Board of Review has recommended that the Council authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into contracts in a form substantially similar to Exhibit "1," with the towing companies listed in Exhibit "2."
3. The towing companies listed in Exhibit "2" have been approved by the Towing Board of Review following a rigorous application process to determine their fitness for inclusion in the Contract. The application process included evaluation of towing and business experience, examination of their business practices, criminal and DMV records checks, certification of drivers, and inspection of all tow trucks and storage facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to enter into contracts for vehicle towing and storage service in a form substantially similar to that attached to this ordinance as Exhibit "1," with the towing companies listed in Exhibit "2."
- b. Contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not be effective, and the Tow Contractor shall not begin performing work, until the Tow Contractor has filed with the City Auditor all required bonds and insurance in a form approved by the City Attorney, and has complied with all conditions imposed by the Towing Board of Review.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current agreements will expire September 30, 2013 and new contracts are necessary to provide uninterrupted service; Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
